



## HIV/AIDS Statistics for 2005

People living with AIDS in 2005.....40.3 million

- ◆ Adults.....38.0 million
- ◆ Women.....17.5 million
- ◆ Children under 15 years.....2.3 million

AIDS Deaths in 2005.....3.1 million

- ◆ Adults.....2.6 million
- ◆ Children under 15 years.....570,000

People newly infected with HIV in 2005.....4.9 million

- ◆ Adults.....4.2 million
- ◆ Children under 15 years.....700,000

HIV/AIDS by Region: Number of people living with AIDS

- ◆ Sub-Saharan Africa.....25.8 million
- ◆ South and Southeast Asia.....7.4 million
- ◆ Latin America.....1.8 million
- ◆ Eastern Europe and Central Asia.....1.6 million
- ◆ North America.....1.2 million
- ◆ East Asia.....870,000
- ◆ Western and Central Europe.....720,000
- ◆ North Africa and Middle East.....510,000
- ◆ Caribbean.....300,000
- ◆ Oceania.....74,000

Worldwide, approximately 14,000 people are newly infected with HIV every day

- ◆ More than 95% are in low and middle-income countries
- ◆ Almost 2000 are in children under 15 years of age
- ◆ Approximately 12,000 are in people ages 15-49 years, of whom:
  - Almost 50% are women
  - About 50% are between 15-24 years old

Percentage of people needing AIDS treatment in developing countries who are actually getting it.....20%

- ◆ Sub-Saharan Africa.....17%
- ◆ Europe and Central Asia.....13%
- ◆ North Africa and the Middle East.....5%

Percentage of people at risk for developing HIV who are receiving prevention services.....10%
